3. **OVA Hotshotz x Lion City Sailors x Tasek Community Football Program Partnership**

OVA HotShotz was officially launched by Minister Edwin Tong in 2021 and has continued as a community football program that uses soccer as a platform for young children to embrace sports and provides character development opportunities for children with special needs and those from disadvantaged backgrounds.

Through its partnership with the Ministry of Social and Family Development, HotShotz has reached out to children from low-income families. In addition to football training, workshops such as Financial Literacy and Managing Self were also held for the children.

In 2025, Hotshotz teamed up with Lion City Sailors & Tasek Academy & Social Services ("Tasek Sailors") to expand our Community Football Outreach to include more vulnerable communities, such as ComLink and families with young children.

We are proud to share that this program was successfully launched on January 18, 2025, with volunteer students from Victoria School serving as mentors as part of their Values-In-Action (VIA) program, accompanying participants during their Community Football sessions. This year, we look forward to increased student involvement as VJC has also expressed interest.

4. **Sporting Excellence Sponsorship for VS and VJC**

OVA, along with our supportive and generous OVA Football Team, raised over \$25,000 to fund high-performance training equipment and coaching for our sports teams representing VS and VJC. Equipment includes cross-country racing shoes, mini football goalposts, javelins, pole vaults, starting blocks and hurdles.

We are proud that VJC is a double champion in the NSG A boys' and girls' cross-country championships for the first time in 20 years.

We are also proud that Jiang Yunfan, a Year 4 student from Victoria School, won the bronze medal in pole vault with a jump of 4.40m at the Bahrain 2025 Asian Youth Games. Singapore's first athletics medal since the 2009 inaugural AYG, where Singapore took home four bronze medals as the host nation.

5. **OVA Wong Hung Khim Golf Fellowship 2025**

Together with our passionate alumni, OVA organized the OVA Wong Hung Khim Golf Fellowship 2025 on October 22 at Tanah Merah Golf & Country Club.

We want to express our heartfelt appreciation to participants and our alumni for their generous support of the event. Half of the flights sold within just four hours of launch! We are greatly encouraged by it.

The funds raised will be used to publish "Greater than Ourselves," a commemorative OVA book celebrating VS's 150th anniversary. This publication features Victorians from all backgrounds - teachers, students, support staff, and alumni - with remarkable stories to inspire current and future Victorians to lead meaningful lives and pursue a purpose Greater than Ourselves. It will feature individuals or groups from different generations. This book honors the enduring legacy and leadership of Victorians across various aspects of society, who have made a significant impact both locally and globally
